

ACCOMMODATION AT "MAKHULU MAGHODI" LODGE CAMP

Forget preconceived ideas about tents! We offer a tranquil bushveld experience with special touches and attention to detail. All units have beds (the Bow tents have Disco beds), linen, towelling and carpeting/mats. Complimentary teas, coffees and toiletries are offered in the Lodge and Chalet units, using flasks. This is also available in the dining room, for Bow units and guests relaxing in the dining area. All bathrooms have hot water and flushing toilets. We do not supply swimming towels. Ours is a true bush camp and as such, there is no electricity: we utilise gas and paraffin.

There is a large, grassed, private garden with 4 thatched lapas, offering shade, at the waterfront (with electricity) and braais that ONLY Lodge camp guests may use, if there are no functions booked in this area (No day visitors are allowed in this area). If this area is being used for functions we will provide an alternate thatch area to you. The waterfront area is used to swim, scuba dive, picnic or just relax.

Meals: A delicious Full English breakfast is served in the morning and is included in the tariff. There is a fully licensed bistro and bar (coffee shop) at the waterfront "Geckos" where Toasted Sandwiches, Burgers, Tramezzinis, Salads and other meals are served. This is open daily. **Please note: our coffee shop stays open until 6pm on Friday, Saturday & Sunday evenings, from 1/Oct. – 30/Apr. & till 5pm from 1/May – 30/Sept. We can also arrange a picnic "basket" dinner for you, from our coffee shop menu. This will need to be pre-arranged and pre-paid for. Please also note our main gate closing times are as per our coffee shop times. If you would like to go out, you may request a remote for the gate. A deposit of R200 is required and refunded on return of the remote**

NO SELF CATERING IS ALLOWED AT THE CAMP. YOU MAY BRAAI AT THE WATERFRONT IF YOU WISH.

We do NOT allow guests to braai at the Makhulu Maghodi, due to Fire hazards.

FOUR TYPES OF ACCOMMODATION OFFERED (TARIFF INCLUDES BASS LAKE GATE ENTRY RESORT FEES):
(Items 1. + 2. are Luxury Lodge Units with Private Bathrooms, Items 3.+ 4. are Back – Packer Standard + Budget Units, which utilise the Central Ablution, which is of a high standard).

1. Lodge Tents: These tents all on their own private sites, are spacious and offer a romantic and unique environment in which to relax. One Lodge incorporates a Victorian Bath in an en- suite bathroom; the others incorporate private bathrooms with showers. Each site has a private shaded patio with cane arm chairs. Complimentary T&C in unit.
2. Family Lodge Unit: This unit (brick walls, with a tented roof) is on its own private site and has 2 sleeping areas, sleeping 4 in total: 2 Adults and two children under 80 kgs (**). The unit has an en-suite bathroom (with a separate toilet and separate shower) and a shaded patio area with seating for 4. There is no lounge or kitchen area: it only has sleeping areas, bathroom facilities and a patio. Complimentary T&C in unit.
3. Standard A Frame Units: Occupants utilise a central ablution facility, of a high standard. These chalets sleep two. Each unit has a covered patio area with "bundu" chairs. The unit has only a sleeping area and is made of brick walls and a tented roof. There is no kitchen. Complimentary T&C in unit.
4. Standard BOW (Dome) Tents: Although these are budget tents, they are charmingly set up and the atmosphere remains peaceful. Dome tents have a large roof cover with bundu chairs, to sit outside.

Other Services:

In addition we offer the following services and activities, which you can pay for as you wish, where applicable:

- Mountain biking - Around our 75 hectare estate – please bring your own bikes & safety gear. Map available at Outdoor Shop at lower level waterfront. No extra fee.
- Swimming - At the waterfront (Lake- snorkel gear available for hire) or at the Recreation Centre (pool). No extra fee.
- Snorkelling - Unaccompanied : At own Cost : Snorkel, Fins & Mask from R 50 /hour: ID needed, Guardian to sign, if Applicable.
- Scuba Diving - Available for certified Divers: Full Scuba gear may be hired; Air and Nitrox fill services available. Prices available on request
- Kayaking - In the Lake – Report to Outdoor shop at the lower level for guidelines regarding divers. Hire Fee per hour is R30 (Single Seater) or R45 (Two – seater): Permit must be obtained. : ID needed , Guardian to sign, if Applicable.
- Recreation Centre - The facility has a Squash Court, Tennis Court, Children's play area and large Swimming pool. There is No extra fee, for own use of any of these specified facilities- please bring own equipment.
- Walking / Birding - On 4 x 4 trail , map provided, bring foot wear with good ankle support, caps, sun block and water for walk: Unaccompanied: No extra fee. Guide could be hired for the day: fee to be advised, if interested in this service.
- 4 x 4 Trail - Our trail length is 14 kms and has a number of technical sections. If done in full, the trail will take a 4 x 4 around 3 hours. This trail is a natural track and includes ascents/ descents and water sections. R 50 / 4 x 4 vehicle ~payable for Permit Fee
- Bass Fishing Catch & Release Basis. R100/ permit per day. Special rules apply.
May-Aug: bank fishing permitted.
Nov – April: no bank fishing on week-ends & public holidays. Fishing on these days only from boat, with electric motor, or canoe only. Permits in this period limited per day on week-ends & public holidays- pls pre-arrange that you wish to purchase permit.
